

Information upcoming Collective bargaining agreement

Hotel- and restaurant workers union (HRF) Number 11, 2017-10-12

Don't leave information about your trade union membership!

It has come to HRFs knowledge that the employers at Casino Cosmopol is demanding information about the workers trade union membership, or lack of such a membership.

This demand from the employer started right after HRF gave strike notice on Tuesday 10 October 2017, on all four of the Casino Cosmopol in Sweden.

No-one needs to tell their employer or boss that they are a member or not a member of HRF or any other trade union, no matter their reason for asking you.

In Sweden, we have freedom of association!

If the employer persists or if you feel uncomfortable in any way, please contact your local representative or HRF-department.

HRF urges all workers at Casino Cosmopol not to leave information on your trade union membership or lack of membership to your employer. If you already have handed such information to them we urge you to write to your employer and oppose against them to use information on your trade union membership.

HRF have sent a letter to the employers' organization Almega, that strongly condemns this mapping of trade union membership amongst workers
